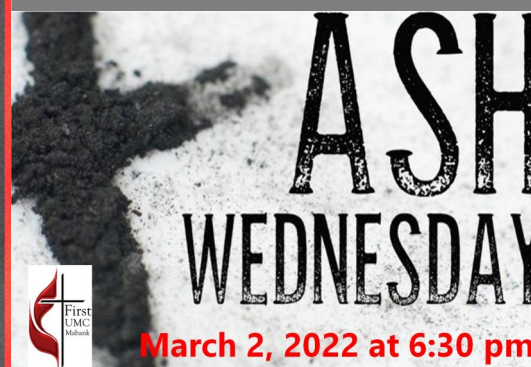
Our Weekly Bible Study will begin on **February 23rd, 2022.**
